^^^^ SUSPECTED URINARY TRACT INFECTIONS In the interest of patient safety and improved care, we no longer allow urine samples to be left in Reception. All patient's must attend an appointment with either the nurse of the GP $\stackrel{\scriptstyle <}{\scriptstyle <}$ with a urine sample. We reported back in the Spring that the surgery had been ranked nationally as 440th in the country out of 7708 GP practices.
